



Bees N Blooms is looking for someone who loves creating and maintaining beautiful landscapes and working with plants. The position is part-time (2–3 days per week), including at least one weekend day. The position starts in mid- to late April and continues through August at least, with potential for ongoing work.

Job Title: Bees N Blooms Seasonal Agricultural Assistant

Job Description: The Seasonal Agricultural Assistant will help maintain our CCOF-Certified Organic farm grounds in southeast Santa Rosa and assist in the nursery. The Lavender Labyrinth and Flower Gardens are the center of activities at the farm, and we also open the farm to the public and host events such as retreats, weddings, picnics, parties, and more. Maintaining the Labyrinth and the gardens requires care and attention to detail. In the nursery, plant care is the main task, ensuring that plants stay watered, fed, and potted up on schedule. Specific responsibilities are outlined below. This position is minimum two days per week with a preferred start date in mid- to late April and continuing through August, with potential for continuing work.

Responsibilities:

- For the farm grounds:
 - Maintain the Lavender Labyrinth and North Pavilion as a pleasing space, including keeping pathways free of weeds, replanting plants when necessary, and mowing the turf areas.
 - Maintain the Flower Gardens as an easily walkable space, including planting and weeding beds, mowing pathways between beds, and ensuring plants are labeled.
 - Assist when necessary with miscellaneous planting and plant care tasks in the Vegetable Garden.
- For the nursery:
 - Potting up, watering, and fertilizing plants
 - Inventory management
 - Daily documentation of actions for organic recordkeeping
 - Checking out customers using the Square Point of Sale app
 - Interact graciously with customers and assist them where possible

Qualifications:

- Experience with landscaping equipment (mowers, weedwackers, various other tools)
- Experience working with plants or willingness to learn and incorporate constructive feedback.
- Attention to detail is critical for managing documentation, potups, plant labeling, and inventory management.
- Able to work quickly and efficiently.
- Ability to maintain a professional and positive attitude.
- Self-motivated, taking initiative to recognize and implement tasks that need to be done.
- Able to maintain a lively pace of work each day.
- Ability to work independently, as well as in a team setting.
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs.
- Ability to interface well with the public.
- Must be a U.S. citizen or have a green card or work visa.
- Must speak English well.

Compensation: The Seasonal Agricultural Assistant is an hourly, non-exempt position, part-time (minimum 16 hours per week) starting in mid- to late April and continuing through August, with potential for continuing work. Pay rate is \$20–\$22 per hour, depending on experience and qualifications.
