



Bees N Blooms is looking for a special person to help with our annual Lavender Bloom Fest! We are looking for someone who loves interacting with people and has the ability to work weekends, starting in late April and continuing through mid-July at least, with potential for continuing work.

Job Title: Bees N Blooms Seasonal Event and Retail Assistant

Job Description: The Seasonal Event and Retail Assistant will help with the farm's annual Lavender Bloom Fest celebration and other farm events at our CCOF-Certified Organic farm in southeast Santa Rosa. The Lavender Labyrinth and Flower Gardens are the center of activities at the farm, and we also open the farm to the public and host events such as retreats, weddings, picnics, parties, and more. We are looking for someone who loves interacting with people to handle retail sales at the farm stand, event assistance, guest check-in, and light nursery work. Facility with an iPhone for rapid check-in of guests, ability to work our open-farm days (Fri, Sat, Sun), and ability to lift 30 lbs are essential for this position. Generally, the work requires running the farm stand, setting up the Pavilion area during open farm days (weekends) and special events (as needed) and keeping it clean, greeting guests and checking tickets as they arrive, and/or some light nursery work. Specific responsibilities are outlined below. This position is minimum two days per week with a preferred start date in late April and continuing through July 12, with potential for continuing work.

Responsibilities:

- Being available to work the following dates:
 - Sonoma County Farm Trails weekend, May 2-3
 - Mother's Day weekend, May 10-11
 - Lavender Bloom Fest on Saturdays and Sundays, 9 AM to 5 PM, from May 23 to July 12.
 - Lavender Sunset Evenings on select Fridays from 3:30 PM to 9:30 PM. Select Fridays include May 29, June 5, June 12, June 19, and June 26.
 - Additional work may be available, depending on event schedule.
- Run the farmstand, assisting customers with checkout, re-stocking merchandise, and keeping the area clean.
- Accurately manage and record all cash and credit card transactions using Square.
- Assist in the preparation of farm products for sale (lavender, vegetables, plants, eggs, honey, bath and body-care products).
- Set up the Pavilion tables, tablecloths, chairs, and umbrellas and rearrange as necessary for events.
- Assist with preparation for and management of events.
- Keep the Pavilion area clean, including cleaning hand-washing station, hosing out portable toilets, and emptying recycling and waste cans.
- Greet patrons as they enter the property, check them in on the Square app, and direct them to parking.
- Be familiar with the farm map and merchandise, and answer visitor questions about logistics (bathrooms, farmstand, etc.).
- Assist with light nursery work including ringing up plant sales and plant watering.
- Interact graciously with customers.

Qualifications:

- Ability to interface well with the public and enjoy interactions with customers and farm guests.
- Excellent ability to use an iPhone quickly.
- Ability to maintain a professional and positive attitude.
- Self-motivated, taking initiative to recognize and implement tasks that need to be done.
- Able to maintain a lively pace of work each day.
- Ability to work independently, as well as in a team setting.
- Ability to lift up to 30 lbs.
- Must be a U.S. citizen or have a work visa.
- Previous retail, sales, or hospitality experience is a plus.
- Must speak English well. Spanish language is a plus.

Compensation: The Seasonal Event and Retail Assistant is an hourly, non-exempt position, part-time (minimum 16 hours per week) starting late April and continuing through July 12th, with potential for continuing work. Pay rate is \$18-20 per hour, depending on experience and qualifications.
